

## Distribution of Student Reports

### ABOUT

In addition to institutional reporting, all juniors and seniors who take the CWRA+ are eligible to receive Student Score Reports and claim ProExam badges if they qualify. Student Score Reports are made available with your school's Institutional Report and Student Data File. Your school is able to send students score reports through the Proctor Interface.

### SENDING STUDENT SCORE REPORTS

1. Log on to the Proctor Interface, <http://admin-cwra.cae.org>.
2. Click on **Test Administrations** from the menu on the left.
3. Find the most recent Test Administration and click on **Reports** under the **View** column.
4. In the last table, **Student Report Portal**, enable the reports for Juniors/3rd Year Students and/or Seniors/4th Year Students.
5. Click **Send Instructions Email** in the upper right hand corner of the **Student Report Portal** table.
6. Select the recipients. An optional message for students may be added.
7. Click **Send**.

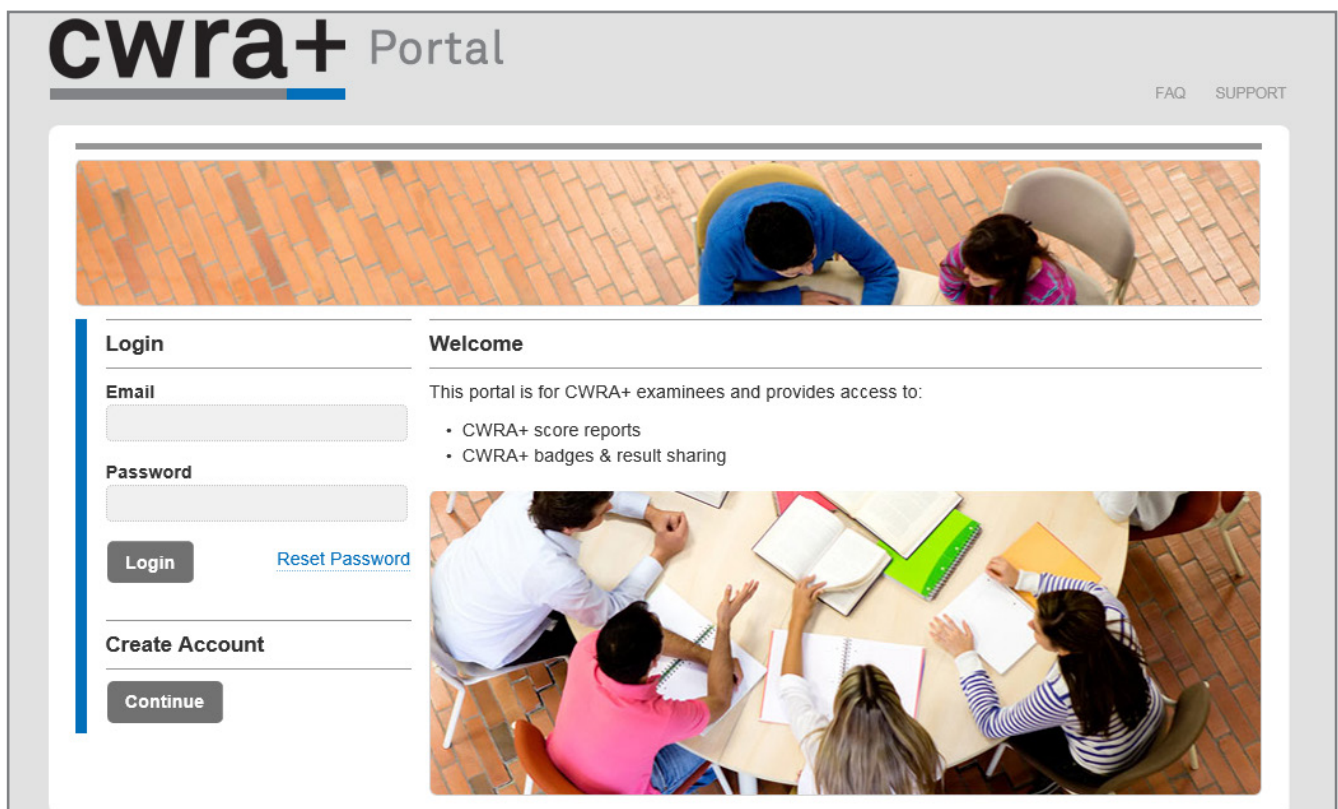
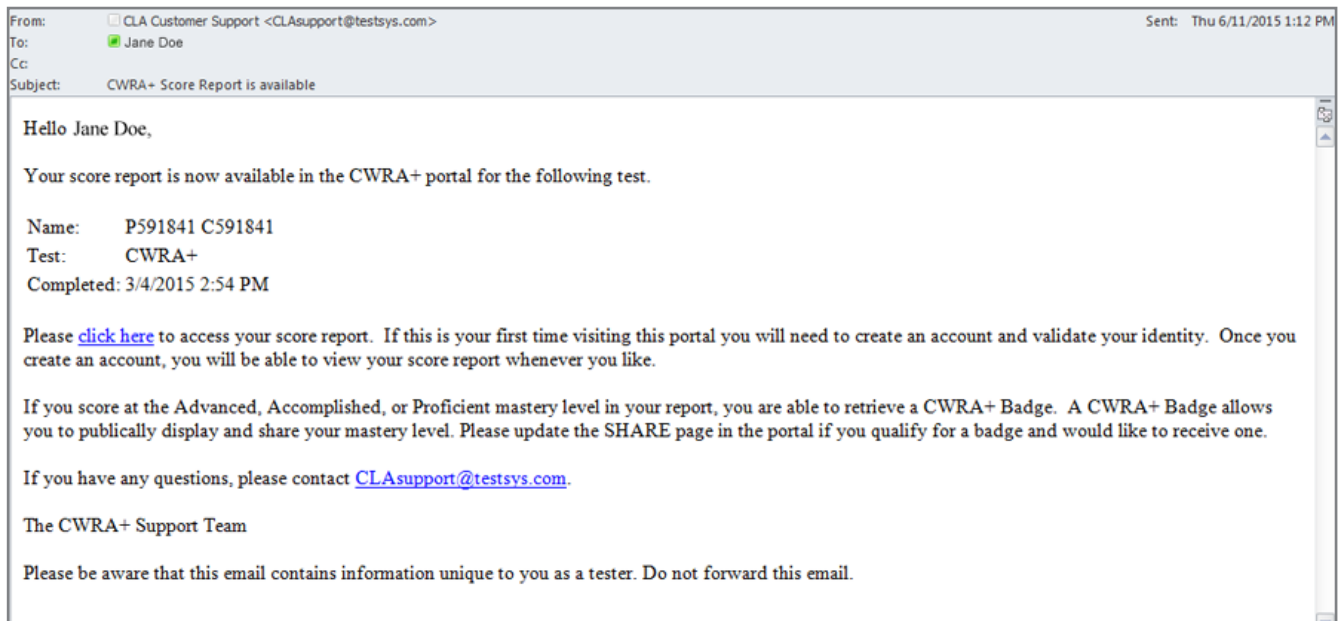

Students will receive an e-mail from [CLAsupport@testsys.com](mailto:CLAsupport@testsys.com) if they are granted permission by their institution to view their reports. The [CWRA+ Student Portal](#) is where students are able to retrieve their score reports and also learn about additional ways of sharing and utilizing their CWRA+ scores.

A complete CWRA+ Student Score Report will provide students with their Total Score, Mastery Level, and Percentile Ranking. It will also show subscores and percentile rankings for the Performance Task and Selected-Response Questions.

Additional information on interpreting their report can be found on the proceeding pages of the score report.

To receive a full CWRA+ Score Report, students must provide a scorable response to the Performance Task and answer at least half of the Selected-Response Questions. Scores of N/A means that one of these requirements was not fulfilled.

# BADGES

By scoring Proficient, Accomplished, or Advanced on the CWRA+, seniors and juniors can claim and display a ProExam badge. ProExam badges allow students to stand out among their peers and appeal to companies seeking these higher-order skills. A ProExam badge can be displayed through an online vault or backpack, an electronic résumé, or a LinkedIn profile. Badges provide verified, specific information from trusted sources about the skills, competencies, and knowledge each individual possesses. A badge supplements a résumé because it showcases a broad range of a student’s skills, particularly the skills that are transferable outside of the classroom and valid from college to the workplace.
