The Secure Browser does not need to be re-downloaded if you already have it on your computer. The Secure Browser will auto-update if you attempt to launch an older copy of it.

We recommend downloading the most current browser(s) for both the Proctor and Student Interface.

## RECOMMENDED CONNECTION SPEEDS AND HARDWARE

<b>Internet Connection</b>	While dial-up modems are supported, we recommend a <b>broadband connection (DSL, Cable, or T1)</b> for best results.
<b>Monitor Size</b>	We recommend a <b>17" monitor or larger.</b>
<b>Resolution</b>	Tests can be delivered at any resolution. Most are designed for resolutions of 800x600 or better. We recommend a <b>1024x768 resolution or higher.</b>
<b>Color Depth</b>	On Windows, the highest resolution is 32-bit color. Ninety-seven percent of users have 16-bit color or greater. Although 8-bit color resolution is supported, it may not present complex graphics perfectly. We recommend a <b>16-bit color depth or greater.</b>

## VISUALLY IMPAIRED STUDENT ACCOMMODATIONS

Students with visual impairments are able to use a magnification feature in the Secure Browser. The minimum system requirement for this function for PCs is Windows 7 operating system and Internet Explorer 10 (or higher). To zoom in, students should press "Ctrl+" and to zoom out, students should press "Ctrl-." On Macs you may use "Command +" and "Command -."
